#### New Membership

#### Renewal Registration

#### **Key Deposit**

You are required to pay a \$50 key deposit upon your initial registration. You will be provided with a key to the track allowing you to practice when it's convenient for you, except for when the track is closed. The key deposit is refundable when track keys are returned to the Treasurer.

#### **Novice Training**

Novice Training consists of a minimum of seven training sessions and one Novice race. Training begins on Saturday, March 4, 2023. Please bring your race car for the first day and if you don't have a car, you should arrange to have one for day two.

#### **Additional Fundraising**

#### **Work Parties**

All members are required to help keeping the track operational during the season. Everything you see at the track was constructed through work parties and donations to the club by the members. The track, buildings, grounds, etc. require constant upkeep in order to keep everything in good condition.

Work parties are listed on the 2023 LQMA Race Schedule and additional work parties will be emailed to members. If you are not able to attend a work party, you can offer to volunteer when it works with your schedule. 20 hrs is required per family for volunteer hours.

Our Club Meetings are held on the fourth Friday of each month at 7:00 pm at track in Langley.
